


What to Expect

- Instruction in construction concepts and practices including green building, hand and power tools, blueprints, math and measuring, framing, sheathing, doors and windows, siding, roofing, insulation, drywall and deconstruction
- Explore advanced technology using virtual reality tools
- Industry speakers, tours and employer contacts
- Assistance with resumes, applications, interviewing, job search, job retention and advancement
- Receive industry recognized credentials: OSHA 10 Authorization, MDOT Flagger and Scissors Lift
- Earn 36 continuing education units and college credit towards Saint Paul College's Carpentry Diploma program
- Training hours: Mon.-Fri., 8 a.m.-2:30 p.m.

DISABILITY **SERVICES**

Our comprehensive disability employment services help adults and youth explore strengths, interests and get ready for work. Learn how employment may impact your public benefits, participate in paid transitional work experience at real work sites or find a job with a variety of employers and get support in your new role.

Employment and Job Support

Personalized, flexible job placement services are the heart of GESMN's mission; we work closely with job seekers and employers to connect people to a career.

Transitional Employment

People with disabilities can get exposure to work through hands-on, paid experience at employer partner sites.

Student Career Services


The transition from youth to adulthood is a critical step for every young person and support is available for students with disabilities. GESMN helps students ages 14-22 with disabilities gain experience to inform career decisions through the following services:

- · Job exploration and job shadowing
- · Workplace readiness training
- Job-seeking skills and self-advocacy
- · Work-based learning
- · Informational interviews
- Workplace tours and field trips
- · Postsecondary educational counseling

ELEVATE Youth

A job exploration program helping youth identify their career interests, connect with employers, gain experience and create a plan for next steps.

- Discover your interests: identify interests and strengths through various assessments, online tools, and discussions. Instruction about in-demand occupations and the skills required through labor market and exploration activities. Youth will select and explore careers with hands-on exposure to a variety of occupations through immersive virtual reality learning experiences.
- Connect with employers: industry tours, job shadows, informational interviews, networking events with local employers.
- Paid work-based learning experiences: develop individualized work experience plan.
- Meet regularly to receive feedback on work performance as reported on work skills rating tool.
 Work to develop soft skills and how they transfer to other employment opportunities. Develop plan for next steps to continue career development







DISABILITY SERVICES (CONT.)

Retail Skills Training

Retail skills training provides job skills to work in the retail industry. Classroom training is combined with paid work experience. This referral based program is not open to the general public.

- 160-hour course
- Hands-on work experience at local retailers
- Instructions in retail terminology, customer service, safety, cashiering, stocking, time management, communication skills, problem-solving and conflict resolution
- Industry speakers
- · Financial literacy training
- · Employment readiness training
- Job placement and follow-up services

On-The-Job Evaluation

Our evaluation helps people with disabilities identify challenges to employment and understand the skills, strengths and accommodations to help them succeed at their jobs.

- Take an evaluation in a real work environment
- Build essential workplace skills
- Receive employment recommendations

Work Incentives Connection

Get disability benefits planning help from experts about Social Security work incentives designed to help you succeed if you are working or want to work.

- Information and referral
- In-depth problem solving

Eligibility: You must be a Social Security beneficiary with disability from ages 14 to full retirement.

FAMILY STABILITY **SERVICES**

Whole family services to meet basic needs and find solutions to help people connect to jobs and build thriving careers. We can help with:

- FATHER Project for low-income, primarily noncustodial fathers offers parenting support, advocacy services, family activities and employment services.
- ReEntry program supports second chances by working with people exiting incarceration to connect with resources to help stabilize their lives with mentoring, employment services and 1-1 case management.
- Employment Services for Hennepin and Ramsey County residents in the Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP) include resume and interview preparation, job search support and more.
- Families Achieving Success Today (FAST) program in Ramsey County supports lifelong learning and wholefamily success using individual placement and support services with culturally specific approaches.
- Family Benefits Pilot offers employment services and financial analysis to help reduce the negative impacts of the benefits cliff for families.
- Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP) provides customized family stability, workforce development and parenting support services to help people achieve financial stability and strengthen future generations in our community.

YOUTH SERVICES

Youth sometimes need extra support navigating into an adult world, especially in finding a career path with family-sustaining wages.

YouthBuild

- For individuals ages 16-24 who are unenrolled in school
- Earn a high school diploma/GED, while gaining construction, automotive credentials and leadership skills
- Receive assistance preparing and applying for jobs
- Stipends and bonuses available

Youth Heading Home

Employment services are provided at the Youth Opportunity Center which offers multiple on-site services for youth looking for housing.
